

# Digital Decade Heatmap

## 2030 DIGITAL DECADE

This heatmap provides an overview of the **2026 Member State-specific Digital Decade recommendations** and their relative prioritisation over different policy areas, with regard to their contribution to achieving **Digital Decade objectives and targets**. Cells outlined in black indicate a corresponding **country-specific recommendation** issued under the [2026 European Semester Spring Package](#), illustrating the complementarity between the European Semester and the Digital Decade agenda.

Please note that the heatmap is structured according to the **Digital Decade targets and general objectives only**. As a result, the display of **European Semester country-specific recommendations** should be regarded as illustrative and intended to provide a broad indication of areas of alignment.

In the **2026 State of the Digital Decade Report, Member State-specific recommendations** concentrate on a limited set of **structural priorities** with the greatest potential to accelerate progress towards the **Union's Digital Decade objectives and targets**. The recommendations are actionable, forward-looking and presented in an indicative order of priority **with 1 being the indicative highest priority**, based on their expected impact and relevance, taking into account the specific national context (see heat map below). This prioritisation is intended to help focus efforts on those areas where reforms, investments and policy measures may have the most significant contribution to **Europe's digital transformation**.
